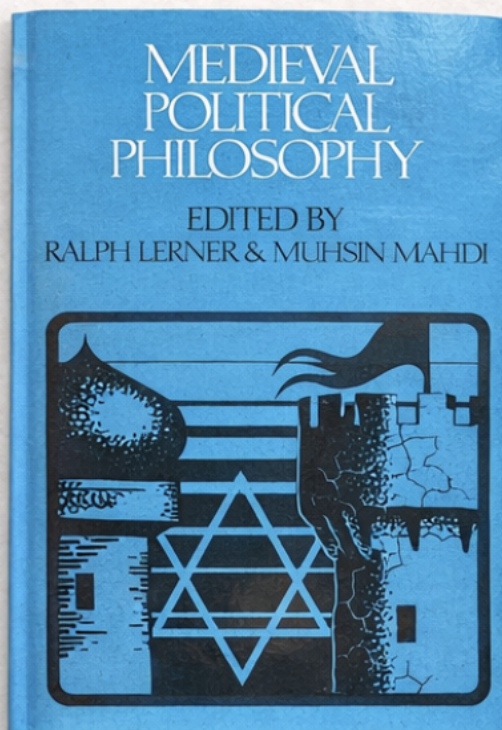


# On the Sources of Medieval Political Philosophy according to Ernest Fortin
